

ONTARIO EAST

CORNWALL HARBOUR

INFORMATION

The Cornwall Harbour is located on the north bank of the St. Lawrence River, just east of the Eisenhower and Snell Locks. Cornwall's strategic mid-point location on the Seaway, approximately 1,700 km from the Atlantic Ocean and 2,000 km from the head of the Great Lakes makes it well suited for industrial water transportation.

The Cornwall Channel is marked by buoys and has a minimum width of 129 m. Sailing directions are found on Canadian Hydrographic Charts #'s 1413 and 1414.

The Cornwall Harbour can accommodate freight transportation activities, including short and long term warehousing of goods at an existing building.
